# Gorse Demonstration Field Days Expression of Interest

The Victorian Gorse Taskforce (VGT) will be hosting four gorse control demonstration field days across Victoria next March and April 2020. Landcare groups may register their interest in supporting the VGT to host a field day for their community.

## Field days

The field days will act as a one-stop-shop about gorse management for private landowners. We will introduce the Victorian Gorse Taskforce, hold a practical demonstration by a local contractor of best practice gorse removal and discuss our annual community grants programs. There will be light refreshments and plenty of time to talk to our extension officer and the local contractors. Environmental representatives from supporting organisations such as DELWP, Parks and local councils will be present (if available). Our extension officer will organise and deliver the day with assistance from the Landcare group.

## Eligibility

The locations and supporting groups will be decided according to the following criteria:

- The presence of gorse and its history in the area
- The availability of a Landcare member to assist the Extension Officer
- Community awareness and drive for gorse control
- The presence of other gorse projects occurring in that area
